## Lions from the Beginning

When Lions Foundation of Canada was established in 1983, it was thanks to Lions clubs across Canada whose dream was to establish a school for Canadians who were blind or visually impaired. The Canine Vision program was introduced and since then the foundation has grown to be the only school in the world to train Dog Guides in 7 unique and distinct programs: Canine Vision, Hearing, Service, Seizure Response, Diabetic Alert, Autism Assistance and Facility Support.



## Demand Continues to Grow

The vision, support and service of Lions through the decades has helped match 3,200 Canadians with Dog Guides. Over 1,100 active teams are currently working together. However, demand exceeds the current capabilities with the wait for a Dog Guide is currently upwards of two years.

The need to continue developing the best Dog Guides is imperative and the only restriction is the lack of space and an updated training environment.

The training school is at maximum capacity for both dogs and people and is not accessible for the people we serve.

Canadians 15 years of age and up are living with one or more disabilities, and more Canadians are seeking the services of a specialized Dog Guide.
