The Canine Vision program was introduced and since then the foundation has grown to be the only school in the world to train Dog Guides in 7 unique and distinct programs: Canine Vision, Hearing, Service, Seizure Response, Diabetes Alert, Autism Assistance and Facility Support.



# **Demand Continues to Grow**
